JAPAN DIY HOMECENTER SHOW 2022

To be held on Thursday 25, Friday 26, and Saturday 27 of this month

The JAPAN DIY HOMECENTER SHOW 2022, one of the largest comprehensive trade show in Japan for housing and living items where domestic and overseas companies related to DIY and home improvement center business gather, will be held as a real show as usual in 3 halls of the Makuhari Messe International Exhibition Hall in Chiba Prefecture from August 25

(Thursday) to 27 (Saturday), 2022, with 319 exhibitors and 860 booths (including 24 booths from 8 overseas companies) and a target of 50,000 visitors. The theme of the JAPAN DIY HOMECENTER SHOW 2022 is "~You can always count on home improvement centers~ Add color to your life with DIY". The show consists of two functions, B to B and B to C with Buyers' Day on the first and second days and Public Day on the second and third days.
