1) "Sanjo Blacksmith Dojo" is a workshop held by a group of craftsmen who take over traditional techniques of smithery in Sajo city in Niigata prefecture.

2) At "Gardening Charity Auction", visitors can find various flowers



and ornamental plants. This is an on-site sale of garden plants by professional auctioneers from flower markets. Proceeds from this event will be donated to welfare organizations.

3) "DIY Family Class" is a handicraft and woodwork class where parents and children can enjoy making things using electric tools. This year, participants will make musical instruments and nest boxes.

4) At "DIY Advisor Mock Certification Test", participants can learn about the DIY advisor qualification test certified by the Japan DIY Industry Association and experience skill tests.

There will be special events including the ironsmith workshop where participants will learn about iron and experience the fun of welding and the paint workshop that women and children can also enjoy. Other events are also being planned, including the event where people can learn about the energy using the natural snow and environment as well as an event that will introduce products and shops from disaster areas in order to support the recovery efforts in those areas.
