The JAPAN DIY HOMECENTER SHOW which was held at the Tokyo Harumi Trade Fair Site, for the first time in 1978 and has been held both in Tokyo and Osaka since then will welcome its 50th anniversary this year. The JAPAN DIY HOMECENTER SHOW 2014 will be held for 3 days on August 28 (Thursday), 29 (Friday), and 30 (Saturday) at Makuhari Messe in Chiba Prefecture, using 5 halls and 1,500 booths (planned). The show theme for the JAPAN DIY HOMECENTER SHOW 2014 is "Inspire your everyday life! Unlimited fun for your daily life with home improvement centers!"

This year, the show will welcome its 50th anniversary. The number of exhibitors from a wide range of categories that focus on the practicality in the daily life and pursue the fun of DIY is expected to increase significantly from the previous year, and many new companies and overseas companies whose number increases every year are also expected to exhibit. Information on events in which visitors can participate

1) "Sanjo Blacksmith Dojo" is a workshop held by a group of craftsmen who take over traditional techniques of smithery in Sanjo city in Niigata prefecture.

- 2) "Gardening Charity Auction" is an on-site sale of garden plants by professional auctioneers from flower markets. Visitors can purchase various kinds of colorful potted plants through the auction-style system. Proceeds from this event will be donated to welfare organizations.
- 3) "Ironworks DIY welding workshop & iron cafe" is an event to have people casually try out the ironsmith work which has a strong image of work for the experienced. There will be also an exhibit of iron cooking tools and miscellaneous goods.
- 4) At "DIY Advisor Mock Certification Test", participants can learn about the DIY advisor qualification test certified by the Japan DIY Industry Association and experience skill tests.

In the theme zone "Glittering! DIY Women" that was well-received last year, there will be many DIY events useful for women including workshops held by exhibitors in order to liven up the DIY boom among women. Also, in this year's show, a new theme zone "Outdoor and Camping Activities" will be added. There will be events that can be participated and enjoyed by both children and adult together including the introduction of information about outdoor leisure activities that can be enjoyed by families or a display of camping cars.
